- **APT 4 Port** – (TVA50 only) Expands the number of ports in the APT Integration from “2” to “4” ports. KX-TA824 V3.0 or higher. See Installation Manual 1.2.2, 4.3, 4.6 and 5.7 for details.
- **Mailbox Number Flexibility** – You can now assign mailboxes with variable lengths and mailboxes that begin with “0”. See Installation Manual 6.1.3 for details
- **Scheduled Backup** – You can now schedule backups in advance. You must create a connection profile on a PC and that PC must be up and running. See Programming Manual 1.9.2 for details
- **Connection Profile** – You can now save connection profiles for your customers. See Programming Manual 1.5.1 and 1.9.15
- **User Level Programming** – You can now create user level programming. See Programming Manual 1.9.9 and 1.3

Changed Content:

- **E-mail Integration** – Change ‘E-mail Integration’ settings in ‘PC Programming Software’ so that it is possible to specify ‘POP Server Address (Name)’. See 2.5.4.12 of the programming manual for details.
- **VM Menu Display** – Caller ID will be displayed on transferred messages.
- **Deleted Messages** – When messages are deleted they will be retained until the end of the day. See 2.3.9 of the feature manual and 2.2.2 of the Programming manual for details.
- **PBX Time Synchronization** – The TVA will sync the time with the PBX once per day (4:00 AM). The TVA PBX Time Synchronization must be set to ‘enable’ See 2.4.10 for details.
- **Default value of system parameters** – Default value of ‘Caller ID Callback’ in ‘Transfer to Outside’ in System Parameters has been changed from ‘Disable’ to ‘Enable’.
